The U.S. Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) is issuing [Russia-related GL 53A](#), "Authorizing Transactions for Diplomatic Missions of the Russian Federation Involving Gazprombank Joint Stock Company or Prohibited by Directive 4 under Executive Order 14024," [Russia-related GL 55C](#), "Authorizing Certain Services Related to Sakhalin-2," [Russia-related GL 113](#), "Authorizing the Wind Down of Transactions Involving Certain Financial Institutions Blocked on November 21, 2024," and [Russia-related GL 114](#), "Authorizing Certain Transactions Related to Debt or Equity of, or Derivative Contracts Involving, Certain Entities Blocked on November 21, 2024."

Additionally, OFAC is issuing two new Russia-related Frequently Asked Questions ([FAQ 1201](#), [FAQ 1202](#)), and three amended Russia-related Frequently Asked Questions ([FAQ 976](#), [FAQ 1096](#), [FAQ 1197](#)).
