The Department of the Treasury's Office of Foreign Assets Control (OFAC) is issuing [Russia-related General License 25E](#) - "Authorizing Transactions Related to Telecommunications and Certain Internet-Based Communications."

Additionally, OFAC is publishing an alert, "[Russian Attempts to Evade Sanctions Using New Overseas Branches and Subsidiaries](#)," to warn foreign jurisdictions and financial institutions about Russia's attempts to evade sanctions by opening new overseas branches and subsidiaries of Russian financial institutions.
